

An OPD is an "Overfilling Protection Device" .

Reference: NFPA 58: LP Gas Code, Page #12, Ch. 2 Pgh. 2.3.1.5 (d) Exemption No.2

The above referenced NFPA code paragraph lists the EXEMPTION below under Paragraph (d).

"Exemption No.2: Cylinders manufactured prior to October 1, 1998 and designed for use in a horizontal position for which an overfilling prevention device is not available. Such cylinders shall have a label to indicate that they are not equipped with an overfilling protection device."
